REQUEST FOR PUBLIC FILING

Paragraph 2 of the Protective Order provides that the government “shall identify that portion of the discovery that includes personal identification information, private health information, sensitive financial information and other sensitive information as “Confidential.” The government has nonetheless marked *all* of the electronic discovery produced to Nazira Haji Zada as “confidential.” Paragraph 11 of the Protective Order signed by the Court on July 30, 2026, prohibits the public filing of any document that contains information the government has produced during discovery and marked “confidential,” without prior authorization from the Court. On August 10, 2026, counsel for Ms. Haji Zada submitted for filing Respondent’s Motion for a Prompt Release Hearing and Memorandum of Points and Authorities in Support of Release. Page 13 of the motion contains a quotation from a grand jury transcript produced by the government and, like all of the discovery, marked “confidential.” Ms. Haji Zada, through counsel, respectfully seeks authorization to file this document publicly.
